Dear Parents (Kind Attention to Grades 9, 10, 11, 12),

We have received complaints from Housing Cooperative Societies through the Indira Nagar Police Station that Secondary and Senior Secondary students are gathering in groups outside the school campus, in front of shops and entrances of these Housing Co-operative Societies and indulging in behavior that is creating nuisance for the shop-owners and homeowners while creating obstruction to general traffic.

We have decided to take stringent action in this regard. We solicit your cooperation to ensure this wholly avoidable issue is resolved at the earliest.

In view of the above please take note of the following Issues and Corrective Measures:

1) Students have a tendency to gather around in groups outside the School Campus after dispersal at 2.00 pm. In some cases, it has been observed that the students continue to be loitering for as long as 30 mins after the school disperses. During this time period, they obstruct the entrances to the Shops causing loss of business for these enterprises. While they are seemingly having a good time with their friends, their merrymaking is clearly causing nuisance to general public.

This tendency of gathering in groups on occasion has also degenerated into fights amongst themselves and incidents of unruly behavior with the shop-owners and passersby.

We also have reports that some students are meeting with their friends from other schools/colleges and indulging in hooliganism



The School's security personnel will be conducting a survey of such vehicles and handing over a list to the Indira Nagar Police Station for further action on Monday (12.09.2022).

In case your ward has a valid Driver's License, please mail a copy of the same to your ward's Class Teacher on or before 11.09.2022. Such Two-wheelers will be allowed to be parked inside the school campus w.e.f. 12.09.2022

3) Parents are strictly advised to not allow their wards to carry Smartphone's and Smart watches to school. Periodic bag-checking will conducted at the School and all such articles will be confiscated.

Parents are also advised to check their ward's bags routinely for any undesirable articles

Parents are specifically advised to monitor their ward's friend circle and ensure that the kids are not befriending kids who are much older than them especially college going students. There is no occasion for such friendship. Generally keep acquaintance with your ward's friends and ideally their parents.

4) Parents are strictly advised not be issue any pocket money on regular days and especially on Birthdays. The area around the school is crowded with several eateries and students have a tendency to crowd around them after school.

In case they wish to have a general get together with their friends or have a birthday party in any of these places around the School, they should do so under your supervision and strictly in the evenings.



Our students come from respectable homes and are studying in a reputable institution and this behavior reflects poorly on all of us. We therefore urge parents to join hand with us to inculcate strict behavioral standards

Parents must strictly instruct their wards to leave for home as soon as they have left the school campus. Students who go home by walk or cycle, leave the school campus latest by 02.15 pm. Assuming they reside close by, they should be home by 02.30 pm maximum. Please monitor their arrival time to check if they are not coming too late

The School will be installing cameras to monitor the front areas of Housing Societies to the direct Right and Left of the School. **Disciplinary Action** will be taken against students who are found gathered in these areas, **10 mins after the dispersal**

The School will be deploying security personnel to clear out the area around the School Campus after dispersal. Please advise your wards to follow their instructions.

2) It has been brought to our notice that, several Grade 10, 11, 12 students who do not yet have a Driver's License continue to bring Two wheelers to school. As per School policy, they are not allowed to travel to school on two-wheelers without a valid Driver's License. We cannot provide parking inside the school campus of vehicles. These students are then parking their two-wheelers in colony roads around the school campus, creating obstruction for residents and shop-owners. This is a grossly illegal activity and in case traffic police department takes action against these vehicles, the parents of these students will be held liable. We urge parents to be mindful of this and not provide two-wheelers to their wards unless they have a valid Driver's License.





The purpose of Education is to make Good Citizens and therefore this issue must be handled with great responsibility by us. We solicit your whole-hearted cooperation in this regard
